The land owners work with local people, the local councils and other organisations to look after the area for people and wildlife.

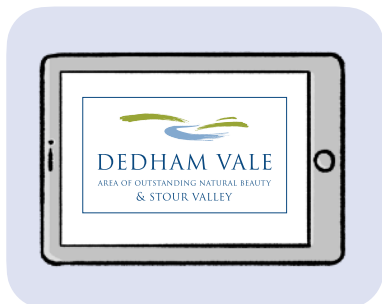


People go to the area to see the views.

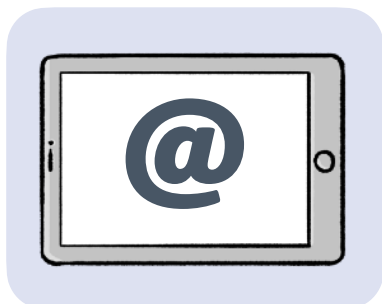
